Anti Social Behaviour

This month our warden, Georgina, has reported several examples of things being taken from front gardens. This can be costly and upsetting, especially when people have invested money, time and energy in creating a garden to be proud of. These may seem like thefts that are not worth reporting but it is REALLY important to report all such matters to the police by dialing 101. We have challenged the waiting time you sometimes have when calling 101 and have been advised that there are now more operators who have been better trained so, please persevere and report all thefts or criminal incidents. This will have the effect of raising the issue on low level crime in our village and will prompt greater support from the police.

Please also try to secure those items that you do put outside- this will prevent the thefts in the first place.

Church Lane – Double Yellow Lines

We are all aware of the traffic problems in Church Lane particularly the section between the A2 and the bridge. This issue has been raised and discussed on numerous occasions at council meetings. Recently double yellow lines were introduced under the bridge. This has been welcomed by many villagers.

However, at the May meeting a local resident voiced concerns that one effect of the introduction of these lines was an increase in traffic speeds and thus an increased risk of serious injury to children whilst walking along Church Lane to and from school.

The local resident went on to say that they would like to see the yellow lines removed and they had the support of many parents.

Councillors will be meeting Kent Highways in June for the annual inspection. They will visit Church lane and discuss these issues.
