## Doorstep criminals claiming to be from Energy Company



We have received reports of doorstep criminals knocking on doors in Canterbury and Swale claiming to be from an Energy Company.

The criminals tell residents that due to gas works being carried out on the A2 (Canterbury Road) they may need a new gas meter and they ask to check it. Once inside the criminals are seen to be looking around the property.
